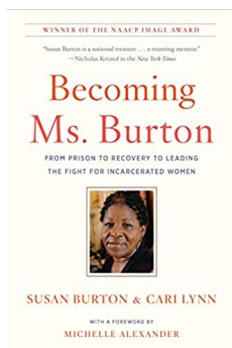
“Becoming Ms. Burton”

Her organization, A New Way of Life, operates five safe homes in Los Angeles that supply a lifeline to hundreds of formerly incarcerated women and their children. *Becoming Ms. Burton* details her remarkable personal transformation.
