Sukkot begins on the evening of Friday, September 25, 2026. We encourage you to welcome this beautiful holiday by building your own *Sukkah* and by celebrating with your own *Lulav* and *Etrog*.

Known as *Arba Minim* or the “Four Species,” these symbolize the beauty and bounty of the harvest in the Land of Israel. Some say that they represent the parts of the body. Others say that the plants represent different types of people.

Join with us in celebrating *Sukkot* with your own set. Each set consists of a *Lulav* (palm branch) with palm holder, *Hadassim* (myrtle branches), *Arovoth* (willow branches) and an Israeli *Etrog*.
